Dear Sir:

My name is Paul Daniel. I am a 19 year old Canadian high school student. For the past ten years, I have researched the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. I have read many books on the matter including the Whitewash series. I have been unable to get a copy of Post-Mortem, as I'm studying the wounds to President Kennedy and John Connally at the present time.

With the books you have written, I have greatly admired your courage and undying loyalty to the memory of John F. Kennedy. Since you have studied the assassination longer than I have, I'm hoping that you can find time in your busy schedule to answer the questions listed below.

1. Why was an ambulance waiting for Oswald, at the Dallas Police Department basement, before he was shot? *None was*
2. Were there CIA Agents at Parkland Memorial Hospital? *one came later*
3. When Oswald was exhumed, did pathologists notice his right hand fingers broken? *not that I know of*
4. Do you know where I can write to Evelyn Lincoln? *no*
5. Who do you think killed President Kennedy? *I don't know*
6. Did Oswald carry curtain rods to work on November 22, 1963? *I think so*
7. The Rockefeller Commission said that the three men arrested by the Dallas Police at the railroad yards were not E. Howard Hunt nor Frank Sturgis. Who do you think they are? *I don't know*
8. Do you think Oswald was at all involved? *Even if a patsy, he was*
9. Were the famous Oswald "backyard photos" altered? By who? *Don't know*

10. Do you believe the Warren Commission wrote a report that they knew was false? *yes*
11. Do you know where I can write to Clinton Hill? *no*
12. Did Oswald know Ruby? *(writ thru to)*
13. Was Heward Hughes part of the conspiracy? *no*
14. Who shot J. D. Tippit? *I don't know*
15. Do you believe notes were taken of Oswald's interrogations? *yes - just in brief*
16. The Warren Commission Report contains reports from all people who were involved in the Oswald interrogations, between November 22-24, 1963. U. S. Postal Inspector, Harry D. Holmes, who was also involved in the Oswald interrogations, filed a report on his observations which was included in the Warren Report. As well as Holmes' report, there is also a report which states almost the same observations as Holmes states in his report, however at the top of the page on the report, the name is identified as FBI Confidential Informant T-7. The Warren Commission never identified FBI Confidential Informant T-7. Who is/was FBI Confidential Informant T-7? *This is standard FBI practice with a source*

I would like to thank you sir for your time and consideration in reading this letter. I sincerely appreciate the time you have taken as I anxiously await your reply.
