STEIG, 713 Winifred Street, Garland, Texas, advised he attended a meeting of the Student Directorate of Cuba held on a Sunday evening at 8:00 p.m. some time during the month of October, 1963. There were about 75 persons present at this meeting which was held at the First Federal Savings and Loan Association Conference Room in the North Lake Shopping Village in Dallas, Texas. Mr. STEIG stated that he sat in the back of the room and listened to several speakers who talked about the situation in Cuba. STEIG stated that another individual sat in the back of this room who he believes is identical with LEE MARVEY OSWARD. This individual spoke to no one but merely listened and then left. Mr. STEIG stated that most of the persons present signed a guest roster which was taken by a Miss SARAH CASTILLO who held some position with the Student Directorate of Cuba.

Miss SARAH CASTILLO, 2177 Valley Ridge Drive, Dallas, Texas, advised she at one time was secretary for the Student Directorate of Cuba and on Sunday, October 13, 1963, at 8:00 p.m., her organization held a meeting in the assembly room at the First Federal Savings and Loan Association building in North Lake Shopping Village, Dallas, Texas.

Miss CASTILLO stated among visitors present was former General EDWIN A. WALKER. Miss CASTILLO stated she does not recall LEE HARVEY OSWALD being present at this meeting but she did not observe all of the visitors. Miss CASTILLO stated that most of the persons present signed a guest roster which has been forwarded to Miss ANNA DIAZ-SILVEIRA who is with the Cuban Student Directorate, whose address is Post Office Box 613, Miami 45, Florida.

On December 21, 1963 interview was conducted at Miami, Florida in connection with information that had been received from SYLVIA ODIO, a Guban refugee at Dallas, Texas, who advised that in September or October, 1963, she had been contacted by two members of the anti-FIDEL CASTRO organization Junta Revolucionaria (JURE), in connection with a funds drive they were conducting: ODIO stated they were accompanied by an individual whom they introduced as LEON OSWALD, whom Miss ODIO stated to be identical with LEE HARVEY OSWALD. Miss ODIO said that one of the two members of the JURE contacting her was named LEOFOLDO.

On December 21, 1963, Mrs. ROGELIO CLENEROS, 347 N.E. 36th Street, Miami, Florida, stated that her husband is a member of the Executive Board of JURE at Miami, and that he was then in Central America. She said in approximately June, 1963 her husband had traveled alone from Miami to Dallas, Texas, to set up a delegation of JURE in that city, and to her knowledge no other JURE member had gone to Dallas; from Miami since that time. She said she could think of no JURE member named LEOPOLDO.

She advised that the JURE delegate in Dallas is JORGE RODRIGUEZ ALVAREDA, 1919 LLewellyn, Apartment A, Dallas. She said Mr. RODRIGUEZ would have knowledge of any JURE members visiting that city.

Interviews at Miami, Florida, were also conducted pursuant to information that EDWIN L. STEIG of Garland, Texas, had advised that an individual believed identical with LEE HARVEY OSWALD had attended a meeting -18MM 105-8342 JJO:JMS

of the Student Directorate of Cubs, held in Dallas, Texas, at 8 PM on October 13, 1963. It was further advised that a guest roster obtained at that meeting had been forwarded to Miss ANA SILVEIRA of the Student Directorate at Mismi, Florida. FD-302 (Rev. 1-25-60)

Miss ANA SILVEIRA, age 28, 1309 Brichell Avenue, Miemi, Florida, a member of the Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil (DAE - Student's Revolutionary Directorate or Student's Directorate of Cuba), advised that she had gone to Ballas, Texas, from Mismi, Florida, for an open meeting of the DRE in that city, hold on October 13, 1963. She stated that on October 13, 1963 a meeting for Spanish speaking persons was held at about 1 PM in the Dreyfus Club, Ballas, and she estimated about 70 persons attended this meeting.

She said a second meeting was hold at 8 PM, October 13, 1963 in a conference room over a bank in a shopping center at Dallas, and this meeting was for English speaking persons, and she estimated about 30 attended. She stated that these meetings had previously been advertised at Dallas in order to give the interested public an opportunity to hear discussion by DRE members of the Cuban situation.

Miss SILVEIRA stated at the meeting on the evening of October 13, 1963 a sheet of paper was passed among those in attendence and those who were interested in receiving the bi-weekly English language publication THE CUEAN REFORT, which is composed by the DRE in Miami, were requested to furnish their name and address. She stated she also made note of the names of those individuals present who made contributions to the DRE at the Meeting.

Miss SILVEIRA stated she had the list at the office of the DRE in Miami, and she was relatively cartain that the name of LEE HARVEY OFWALD was not included in the list. She further stated she has seen many

On December 23, 1963, Miss SILVEIRA was contacted at the DRE offices, 1705 S.W. 3rd Avenue, Miami, Florida, at which time she wade available the list of these who attended the meeting in Dallas on the evening of October 13, 1963. This is a typewritten list and Miss SILVEIRA explained that she had disposed of the original paper bearing the names and addresses which had been passed in the audience at Dallas.

Miss SILVEIRA pointed out that the last nine names on the list were the names of individuals who attended a meeting by the DRE at Fort Worth, Texas, held at approximately 5 FM on October 20, 1963 at a bank near Fort Worth on the expressway running from Fort Worth to Dallas. Miss SILVEIRA said this meeting was also for English speaking parsons and had been requested by Mrs. W. A. LANFER, 5309 Rutland, Fort Worth, who had attended the meeting on October 13, 1963 at Dallas.

JOAQUIN MARTINEZ HE PINILLOS, age 22, stated ha is in charge of publishing THE CUBAN REPORT for the DRE, 1705 S.W. 3rd Avenue, Miami, Florida. He stated that ANA SILVEIRA, MANUEL SALVAT, the latter an officer of the DRE, and himself, traveled from Miami to Dallas, Texas, in October, 1963 for the purpose of holding public meetings to inform those interested of the work the DRE has done and hopes to do with respect to the CASTRO regime in Cuba. Mr. PINILLOS stated that DEAN FERKINS, 11022 Cennotta Drive, Dallas, Texas, assisted the DRE in organizing the meetings and arranging the publicity attached to the meetings.

He said this publicity included an appearance on a television station at Dallas, and also contact with the DALLAS MORNING STAR, a daily newspaper published in Dallas.

Mr. PINILLOS stated Miss SILVEIRA and himself addressed the English speaking audiences which attended the DRE meetings. He said that in addition to the meeting on the evening of October 13, 1963, in Dallas, two meetings were held at the University of Dalles, one at Southern Methodist University, Dallas, and one at some High School in Dallas. He estimated that at the meetings held in Dallas on October 13, 1963, approximately 50 to 60 persons attended the afternoon session, which was addressed by MANUEL SALVAT, and approximately 25 to 30 attended the evening session. He stated at neither of these meetings did any one in the audience attempt to bring up any debate or agitation. He said that he did not give any close observation to any of the English speaking persons present on the evening of October 13, 1963, and therefore could not state whether LEE HARVEY OSMALD may have been present.
