THREAT TO WIFE OF REVEREND WILLIAM HOLMES  
9018 Aldwick Drive  
Dallas, Texas

On 11/27/63, at 12 Noon, a Borden Milk deliveryman, who services the residence of SA ODUM, advised MRS. ODUM that the Reverend WILLIAM HOLMES, 9018 Aldwick Drive has received a threat on his life, and that there is an armed guard set up in front of his house where men with shotguns are checking persons who drive by the house too slowly. This is believed to be members of the Dallas Police Department.

Reverend WILLIAM HOLMES, Pastor, North Haven Methodist Church, Dallas, reportedly appeared on CBS television 11/26/63, reporting flippant cheering by students of a Dallas High School when they heard of President KENNEDY's assassination.
