FBIHQ expresses a keen interest in Captain J. C. Bowles making available to the FBI the John F. Kennedy acoustical data which he has compiled over the years.

Jeffrey I. Fogel, Departmental Attorney, General Litigation and Legal Advice Section, Criminal Division, Department of Justice, concurs with FBIHQ in that Captain Bowles' data should first be made available to the FBI.

[redacted] Personal Crimes Unit, Criminal Investigative Division, has discussed this matter with SA [redacted] Signal Analysis Unit, Engineering Section, Technical Services Division, and SA [redacted] of that Unit, both of whom remain available to receive Captain Bowles' JFK acoustical data.

By way of information, SAs [redacted] and [redacted] prepared the FBI's 11/19/80 "Review Requested by the Department of Justice of the Acoustical Reports Published by the House Select Committee on Assassinations." A copy of this review was provided to the Dallas Division via Buairtel dated 12/2/80.

The Dallas Division is requested to advise Captain Bowles of the FBI's interest in receiving his acoustical data. SAs [redacted] and [redacted] would tentatively be available to travel to Dallas during the latter part of January, 1981, for this purpose..
