District Attorney Henry Wade received information from MR. F. H. HARRISON SR. who lives at 1718 NORTH TRAVIS STREET, LIBERTY, TEXAS, Telephone number FE-6-3543 Area Code 713 that could possibly show a connection between JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD. The following is a result of this investigation.

MR HAR IS N stated that he had received information that a guard named CABINESS (fnu) of the Texas Prison System had a negro inmate under his supervision that knew JACK RUBY, and that Ruby had contacted this negro about moving Oswald from Dallas to California, prior to the ascassination of President Kennedy.

TDC, was contacted about the above mentioned negro. Cabiness wtated that he knew nothing about this negro. Cabiness stated that what he had said was mis-construed and that the man we (the undersigned officers) wanted to talk to was BORBY JOSEPH SIMONS, w-m, who is an inmate at the Wynne Parm.

Simons stated that he had known Ruby for a number of years and that he always thought that Ruby was a communist. Simons also stated that the negro in question was McKINLEY PATTON, c-m, TDC# 169432. Patton told Simons that he had worked for Jack Ruby at the Vegas Club before he went to the penitentiary. Simons stated that Patton said nothing of Ruby asking him to move Oswald to Galifornia.

Simons stated that a HILTON TURLINGTON (phonetic). probably knew Ruby better that anyone. Simons stated that Turlington is or was a policeman in Waxahachie, Texas.

Captain W. P. GAMNAWAY received information that the SUBJECT had made a statement that JACK RUEY was in the Allright Parking Garage at 1208 Commerce on the afternoon of November 23, 1963. That JACK RUEY had made a telephone call and had asked for WES WISE at the KRID T V Station. RUEY was reportedly told that WES WISE was not in and that RUEY had then talked to a person named MEN (fmu). RUEY was reported to have asked this person when LEE HARVEY OSWALD was to be transferred from the City jail to the County jail and had stated to this person, KEN, (fmu), that he wanted to be there when the transfer was made.

A KIN SCOTT, an artist at KRID T V Station was interviewed and he stated that he had never received a telephone call from JACK Ruby and that he did not talk to Jack Ruby on November 23, 1964.

One KEN SMART, who works the City Desk in the Dallas Times Herald news rocm was interviewed and stated that he had only talked to Jack Ruby one time in his life, that he could remember, and this was several months prior to November, 1963.

hr. EDDIE BARK'R, News Director at the KRID T V Station was interviewed and stated that the above two persons are the only ones with the name "KEN" that he knew and if there were others, they would not be in position to receive telephone calls or dispense any would not be in position to receive telephone calls or dispense any would not be in position to receive telephone calls or dispense any would not be in position regarding current events. Eddie Barker and Wes Wise both information regarding current events. Eddie Barker and Wes Wise both interviewed that JACK RUEY had appeared at the scene of the assassination on the afternoon of Rovember 23, 1964. Wes Wise was at this location in one of the KRID T V Mobil News Units and Jack Ruby came to the side of the unit and engaged Wes Wise in conversation for more than one half hour, discussing the assassination and Lee Harvey Oswald. This was around 1:00 PM in the afternoon.

Page two - Claude Hallmark

Mr. CLAUDE HALLMARK, the manager of Allright Parking Garages was interviewed and first stated that he did not remember any thing about the afterneon of November 23, 1963, except that JACK RUEY did come in the the parking station and that he did use the telephone. He did remember that Jack Ruby had made a telephone call and thought that he had asked for WES WISE and he thought that the name of the person Ruby talked to sounded like "KEN". Hallmark stated that he was not sure of just what was said.

Mr. Hallmark was interviewed a second time, by telephone and upon direct questioning, stated that he did not remember RUEY making a statement about the time of Oswald's transfer or on the point that he wanted to be present at the time of the transfer. Mr. Hallmark then changed this and stated that this was referring to Ruby asking questions on the telephone. That as far as he could remember, RUDI did not ask any questions about the Oswald case, his transfer from the city jail to the county jail or the time of the transfer. Ir. Hallmark stated that as he remembered the events of the afternoon, Jack Ruby came into the office of the parking lot and made a remark to the persons present that he was going to make like a reporter. Pr. Hallmark stated that during the time Ruby was on the telephone, he did most of the talking and appeared to be giving information to the other person, the one he was calling, rather than asking questions and receiving information. Hallmark stated that most of the telephone conversation did appear to be dominated by the subject of the Presidents assassination and Leo harvey Oswald but that he did not remember any specific remarks or statements nor did he hear a specific question regarding Les Harvey's transfer nor the time of the transfer.

SUBJECT and his wife stated that they met MARINA OSWALD through GEORGE BOUHE sometime in August, 1962. Not long after this, the HALLS said they separated and SUBJECT left town. HARINA moved in with ELAINA and stayed at her house for three weeks in October, 1962, while LEE HARVEY OSWALD was in Dallas looking for a job.
