SUBJECT stated that on Friday Movember 22, 1963, at approximately 2:15 A. W. a white male, five feet seven inches tall, 1ho lbs. with dark hair, entered the LUC'S B & B CAFE, located at 3520 OARLAN, there SIPJICT is a maitress. STPJICT stated that this man was positively LUCKEY OTALD. SUBJ. CT said this man stated that he was waiting for JUCK BUBL. SUBJ. CT stated that JACK SUBJ entered the CAFE a short time later but did not sit in the booth with this men. The man believed to be COMMAIN went over and set with JACK RUBY. SUBJECT stated that RUDY and the man believed to be OSUALD left at approximately 2:45 A, H. At this point in the interview the SUBJECT stated that she could not be sure that this men was OS-MLD but if he had a small deep scar on his left check, it was him.

SUBJECT stated that a few days after the ascassination she received an anonymous telephone call telling her to get out of town or she would die.

Before the interview ended the SUBJECT stated that she could not be positive but she thought the man with RUBY was OSWALD.

SUBJECT, who resides at 5906 WOODVILLE, has been an employ of the TEXAS SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY, HOUSTON & ELM, for seven months.

SUBJECT stated that he knew LIE HARVEY OFWALD when he saw him but that he did not associate with him. He stated that OSWALD stayed by himself most of the time. SUBJECT stated that he was in the entrance of the building when the President was assassinated. SUBJECT stated that he did not see anyone leave the building after the shots were fired. SUBJECT stated that on the day of the assassination he saw OSWALD only one time and that was at 10:00 A. M. SUBJECT said he had never seen JACK RUEY until he saw him on television.
