On 11/27/63, a female individual, who refused to identify herself, telephonically advised SA CARL E. UNDERHILL that she had a daughter who is known as CAROL ANNIE DEAVERS, who, at the present time, is about 21 years old, but with whom the caller has had no contact for over a year. The caller said she had heard the DEAVERS had gone to Mississippi with a hair dresser.

The caller advised that DEAVERS had at one time worked at the Carousel Club and later had worked at the Colony Club and that she had been introduced into this type of life by a Dallas police officer by the name of SA SWAFFORD. She said SWAFFORD had started talking around with her daughter when the daughter was about 17 years old. She said she had complained at that time to the Dallas PD and SWAFFORD had been transferred to another division but he was later discharged.

The caller said she did not know if this was of any significance, but she wished to furnish this to the Dallas PD Office.

On 12/4/63 Sgt. H. H. STRONGER, Personnel File # 44-1639-101, advised that he had been contacted by his department under the name BOB SWAFFORD. He stated that BOB SWAFFORD was presently working on the 4:00 PM to Midnight shift with the Radio Patrol Division, and he would make a recommendation for interview of BILL H. SWAFFORD on that date.
