

K Renews Vow To Defend Cuba From Aggression

MOSCOW, Dec. 31 (AP) Premier Khrushchev pledged again today that the Soviet Union would defend Cuba against any attack by the United States.

In a cable to Premier Castro marking the fifth anniversary of his revolution, Khrushchev declared:

"On this day, so important for the Cuban people, we again declare that revolutionary Cuba will not remain alone if it is attacked by United States aggressive militarist circles."

He added that "the Soviet people, fulfilling their internationalist duty, will continue to render all-round assistance to their Cuban brothers in their struggle for a new life."

The cable was also signed by President Leonid Brezhnev. The text was distributed by Tass.
