New JFK Assassination Film Reported

DENVER — A previously undisclosed film of the assassination of President John Kennedy has surfaced in Dallas, and has been provided to author-

taced in Dallas, and has been provided to authorities, The Denver Post reports.

The Post said those who have viewed the 8mm color film report it offered a clear view of the grassy knoll in Dealey Plaza in Dallas, where some investigators have theorized a second gunman may have fired at Kennedy on Nov. 22, 1963.

The Post said the recently rediscovered film was shot by Dallas resident lack Daniels. John Signles as
