He said he would be going to Dallas over the week-end for the football game and would return around Tuesday of next week.

I advised Mr. DeLoach of the call and he suggested you be informed of it before any action is taken and he suggested that Mr. Bishop and Mr. Adcock interview him at the Bureau.

Mr. Davidson said he would leave the matter in my hands and would talk to anyone I suggested. I advised him someone would be in touch with him.
