Angels Moved

PALO ALTO, Calif. — While her attorneys sought unsuccessfully to block the move, Angela Davis was transferred quietly yesterday to the San Francisco peninsula city for her long-
awaited trial on murder, kidnaping and conspiracy charges.

The 27-year-old black militant, communist and former UCLA instructor was taken from her cell in the Marin County Jail at 6 a.m. and driven in an unmarked sheriff's car across the Golden Gate to Palo Alto.

Miss Davis is accused of furnishing guns for an Aug. 7, 1970, Marin County shootout, in which a judge and three other persons were shot to death.

The case was ordered moved to Santa Clara County earlier this month, in response to a defense request for a change of venue; its defense had wanted the new site to be San Francisco.
