Pur Par 3/90 FBI Seeks Miss Davis In Germany

FRANKFURT, Aug. 22 (UPI)—Frankfurt police confirmed today the FBI has carried its search to West Germany for Black Panther member Angela Yvonne Davis.

Miss Davis, 26, was placed on the FBI's 10 most wanted list in connection with the Aug. 8 murder of a judge in San Rafael, Calif. She is said to have purchased the murder weapons, police said.

A police spokesman said the U.S. Army's Criminal Investigation Division yesterday asked West German authorities to keep a lookout for Miss Davis, particularly in Frankfurt where she once studied.

Frankfurt press reports said Miss Davis attended philosophy courses in Frankfurt from 1965 to 1968, spoke very good German, and particularly after-the spring of 1968 had ties to radical German student groups.

The reports said police were also searching for Miss Davis in Paris, reputed to be the Black Panthers' European headquarters.
