# Angela's Champion Takes to the Hills

Farmer Roger McAfee, 33, has said he posted the \$100,000 bail for Angela Davis "for publicity and profit." Now he's probably not so sure it was a good idea.

McAfee, who heads a cooperative dairy farm, has had to take to the hills with his five sons after nine of his cattle were poisoned and someone fired shots at his home.

Jeanne Lawson, a member of the cooperative, said the harassed farmer had been receiving "nasty" letters and threatening telephone calls ever since he posted the bail.

The McAfee outfit, known as the Pan American Association, was to have been a cosponsor of the "McAfee Farm Festival," a four-day concert scheduled to begin Sept. 4 on McAfee's farm with the proceeds going to the cooperative.
