Cointelproing the House assassins committee and OFR and CRD

Before the FBI turned its former PCI over to the House Committee it was certain that all of his information was bad and came from public sources on which he embellished.

To make certain that he would not be missed it added his symbol by hand after obliterating it. (44-38861-2000 6168, pg 1 graf 3).

In disclosing him the FBI also knew he was a current and productive informant of DEA and Secret Service: "DEA advised on 12/14/76 that his narcotics information is accurate and reliable and both agencies have pending investigations in which he is furnishing worthwhile information on a continuing basis."

Nonetheless, as is set forth in my affidavits in C.A. 75-1996, the FBI turned Morris Davis, also identified by name in the records attached to these affidavits, the better for the House assassins not to miss him, over to that committee. On 12/21/76 it reported informing CRD and OPR of what it knew was fabricated information. (Both charged with internal re-investigations of the FEI's performance.)

These records leave do doubt that although the FRI knew Davis was a continuing and currently valuable source for both DEA and Secret Service yet was providing only very bad information on the King case, it disclosed his identity in order that what it knew would deceive, mislead and waste the House committee (if not also CRD and OPR) reach it. While this did endangers Davis he did not protest until he was turned ower to Mark Lane.

This and other similar cases are contrary to the FBI's representations made to withhold arbitrary, numerical representations of other informers that, while not identifying them, would permit evaluation of what they provided.
