SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63,
DALLAS, TEXAS

At 5:50 p.m., 11/22/63, an individual who identified himself as [REDACTED] b7D home phone [REDACTED] called the New Orleans Office. [REDACTED] stated he was calling in regard to information he had heard on the radio that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was suspected of assassinating the president. He stated he was aware that OSWALD was connected with the Fair Play For Cuba Committee and wanted to advise this office that if OSWALD shot the president, OSWALD was undoubtedly being paid by the Cuban government.

[REDACTED] stated he formerly resided in New York as a Cuban citizen and worked closely with Chief Inspector McLAUGHLIN (ph) of New York City PD while residing in New York. b7D

Upon questioning, [REDACTED] advised he is acquainted with about 85% of the persons of Cuban extraction who reside in the New Orleans area and would be willing to furnish any information in his possession to the FBI concerning the activities of any persons in the New Orleans area. b7D

It does not appear that [REDACTED] information is of any value in connection with captioned case but it is possible he might be a potential security informant. b7D

It is suggested a copy of this memo be routed to SA deBRUEYS and that consideration be given to contacting [REDACTED] in regard to Cuban matters. b7D
