Mrs. Hal Davison, 4047 Tuxedo Road, AT, Georgia, advised SA Charles S. Harding on 12-16-63 that she has never met subject and has never corresponded with him. Mrs. Davison advised that her maiden name is Natalia Alekseevna.

She stated that her son Aleksis was formerly the Embassy Doctor at the American Embassy in the Soviet Union. She stated that one of his jobs was to examine people leaving the Soviet Union for entry into the U.S. and she believes her son may have examined subject or his wife upon their departure from the Soviet Union and have given them her address since she is of Russian background.

On 1-3-64 a representative of the U.S. Air Force advised that Alexis H. Davison, former Assistant Air Attache at American Embassy, Moscow, was discharged from the Air Force 6-6-63. At that time his forwarding address was listed as 431 Riverside Drive, New York, New York.
