1. Captain Alexis H. DAVISON, who was assigned to Moscow as Assistant Air Attache and Embassy doctor until he was declared persona non grata in May 1963, was coopted [REDACTED] to provide passive communications support for PENKOVSKIY. This support consisted of observing a signal site from his apartment and of standing by to receive a coded telephone signal from PENKOVSKIY. [REDACTED] The signal site and telephone signal were part of an early warning arrangement established with PENKOVSKIY.

2. There is no record of any other operational involvement of DAVISON with [REDACTED] Branch [REDACTED] reflected in the indices of the [REDACTED]

3. None of the records consulted indicate any contact whatsoever between DAVISON and Lee Harvey OSWALD.

4. Our files do not contain any record of any intelligence activities of DAVISON aside from the PENKOVSKIY case. [REDACTED]

5. The above information is set forth without benefit of the official PENKOVSKIY case file, which is in the process of being recalled from Archives. If review of the PENKOVSKIY file suggest elucidation or amplification of the above, pertinent information will be forwarded to your office.
