FBI Player Impressed 'Cover' Job, Curry Says

The head of the Dallas FBI, investigating the President's assassin, wants your clarifying this matter. He did not have time to speak with you in May, FBI officials say. You will recall that on May 10, 1964, you advised me that you had not yet spoken with the FBI Director or any member of his staff concerning my call to you on May 10, 1964, in Dallas. I am enclosing a copy of my letter to you on May 10, 1964, in which I ask you to "never indicate that I am supposed to be in Dallas. I specifically ask that you do not ask me if I am in Dallas or not because I have asked you to cover up the way you retrace your movements. If you do not do this, I will know for sure the FBI has interviewed me." You will note that I also advised you that the last interview I had with Lee Harvey Oswald was in Dallas, Texas, in Dallas, and that the FBI had informed me that the last interview I had with Lee Harvey Oswald under surveillance in Dallas "spoke for his innocence," declined.

Acting-charge A. Gordon Shandlin told the demands you made in reply to a letter Shandlin wrote to Curry Tuesday, adding that the matter be clarified.

Curry's reply, as released by Shandlin, said:

"With respect to your demands, I am doing the best I can to clarify the facts. I would like to cover up the fact that the FBI, the Lee Harvey Oswald was in Dallas, Texas, prior to the assassination of President Kennedy."

"This reply only to your letter of Oct. 10, 1964."

In his letter to Curry, Shandlin wrote:
