Official birthday greet-ings from President Johnson on down are piling up at VOA's headquarters. Johnson said that throughout its first quarter century, "the VOA has never swerved from the course of truth."

For its silver anniversary today, VOA plans to broadcast a special twohour show with singer Bing Crosby as master of ceremonies. Others range from virtuoso violinist Isaac Stern to jazz trumpeter Louis Armstrong-plus foreign artists including the Chinese singer Li Li-hua, Indian composer Ravi Shankar, and the Mohlan singers of Laos.
