Dear Mrs. Degen,

Thank you very much for your letter of 2/5, which Dell has forwarded. I do appreciate what you say. Thus far, we have had no other reward, aside from the satisfaction of doing what must be done.

WHITEWASH III grew so enormous I had to break it down. One part became the enclosed book, which contains about 150 pages of photographic reproduction of once-secret documents that would have been WHITEWASH III. I am using others in other books, each with texts. I have completed three of these but cannot afford to print them. The publisher reluctance to touch this subject has been undiminished and may now get even stronger. Not only is this book entirely unavailable, but wholesalers who did get it refused to fill orders and did other things to interfere with access. They have gone out of their way to make extra problems.

Because you say you want the book, I am sending it. The total charge is \$5.00. While the price is \$4.95, with mail orders we add but the extra nickle to cover all handling and postage charges.

If you are not already on our mailing list, we will add you and let you know when other books are printed.

I'd appreciate it if you would accept this letter as a bill to save us the extra work.
