Dear Mr. Dekker,

Please excuse the delay in responding to your great kindness. My wife has returned to work, temporarily, so that each day's lodd does not increase our debt by that much, so some of what she would do I must. In the past few weeks I have been able to publish limited editions of three books, and this, too, took time. There are very limited, I regret to say, because of cost. I wish I thought they could be printed soon. They are Xeroxed editions. You did help, very much, and we do appreciate it.

The first of these books is POST MORTEM. I had completed it in August of 1967. If you are familiar with the "new" material on the autopsy, including the firm military rather than medical control, the presence of the military and no civilians, the failure to trace the path of the non-fatal wound, etc., that came out in the cross-examination of Dr. Finck in New Orleans, this is the source. The second is POST MORTEM III: SECRETS OF THE KENNEDY AUTOPSY. This is the book I began writing in New Orleans in January and completed after my return. It is from here that Garrison got the fact that the fatal wound was in the top of the head, not the back, the presence of fragments in the thoracic area, etc. I have no doubt I have built solid perjury cases against all three autopsy doctors. I have serious doubt that they will even be prosecuted. The third is a book I did partly in June, completed after my return from New Orleans in July. It is COUP D'ETAT, which I discussed briefly when I was in California last fall. If only I could get responsible Jewish or black groups interested in it, I am confident they could make from selling it more than it would cost to print it. In it I have the untold part of the story of the King assassination, the suppressed FBI evidence on it, including the advance prediction, the blueprinting, and I think the solution to the Birmingham church bombing. I have also the first-person account of the man who blueprinted the JFK assassination, the one responsible for the change in his Miami trip (OSWALD IN NEW ORLEANS, "Preliminary Postscript from Miami" and the stuff about the Castro speech-JFK IPA speech) who took credit for the assassination the day after it and then said "We must now concentrate on the Jews" - and the proof they did. With this I have the related and known threats by these extremists of the right all suppressed by the Commission, from whose misfiling I resurrected it...But reaching them is a problem.

Now I am completing the indexes for these books, for if they can be printed I want also to print in facsimile the documents that were suppressed, so the people can see for themselves. When this is done, I shall pick up with the second part of the autopsy trilogy, POST MORTEM II, for which my research is completed. I have not been able to write it since the winter of 1967. I have for it a number of the files thought destroyed. They include some of the more shocking documents in our history. So, I think you can see that I do stay busy! I find that if I do not do each day's work as it comes up, it is too difficult to catch up again and everything is slowed down that much more....I wish there were more like you. It costs about \$5,000 to print 5,000 copies of a book and the sale of the entire printing cannot yield a profit. Again I thank you, very sincerely.
