Daley's Film Stirs Thoughts

NEW YORK (AP) — Metromedia News has offered four organizations including the Mobilization Committee for the Democratic convention, in Chicago an opportunity to respond

to the film produced by Chicago Mayor Richard J. Daley.

John Corporan, Metromedia television news vice president, said Thursday that the Yippies, the American Civil Liberties Union, the McCarthy for President Committee and the Mobilization committee had all requested an hour to respond to the Daley film.

Daley's film was shown over Metromedia stations and others that requested it. It was a defense of the Chicago Police Department's handling of demonstrators and attempted to show

that antiwar demonstrators posed a serious threat to Chicago and the Democratic National Convention.

Corporan said the four groups met Wednesday but had not reached agreement on how to apportion the hour.

"There definitely will be a show in about two weeks but we don't know how much time each group will get," he said. "Three of the groups said they agree on 15 minutes each but the McCarthy people did not want to merge their efforts with the others."
