## Bomb Hunted As Agnew Talks

YORK, Pa., Sept. 6 (AP)— Three floors of the hotel in which Vice Presidential candidate Spiro T. Agnew was speaking were avacuated and searched Thursday night aft-er a bomb threat was called into the hotel switchboard and the York Gazette and Daily Newspaper office.

The calls, from a woman, came shortly before 9 p.m., about the same time Agnew began his talk. He continued his talk while the third, fourth and fifth floors were searched.
