While I do not plan publication of the pictures, if I should desire to do this, if there will them be an entre charge, let me know and I'll them send you am additional check.

Because they are in evidence, the National Archives will supply print at \$1.50 each. I am writing you to be cartein that I get prints made from the full negative, not cropped pactures.

If you have a stamp, please stamp the credit to yourself on the back. I expect most of my materials to go to a University Archive and I think it would be proper for everything to be credited.

Have you seen or heard of any pictures not introduced into the Commission's evidence that show any part of the assassination story: I am particularly interested in pictures showing the front of the building and the people standing there.

If it is not too much trouble, it would be helpful if on the back of each print you would note the camers, lens and film you used.
