Dodd Probe Will Begin On June 20 United Press International

The Senate Ethics Committee announced yesterday it will begin hearings June 20 into charges of misconduct against Sen. Thomas J. Dodd

(D-Conn.) over his relationship with an agent for West German business interests.

Sens. John C. Stennis (D-Miss.), Chairman, and Wallace F. Bennett (R-Utah), Vice Chairman of the Committee, said the initial hearings will be held in secret, with open

hearings to follow.

In a brief announcement, they added the Committee is continuing its investigation of other allegations against Dodd. Among these have been charges that Dodd diverted campaign funds for his personal use.
