Soviet Peace Aim Decried by Dodd

NEW YORK, Dec. 3 (UPI) Sen. Thomas J. Dodd (D-Conn.) said today it was foolish to think the Soviets wanted peace in Vietnam.

Dodd spoke at the Overseas Press Club where he received an award from the Conference of Americans of Central and Eastern European descent. He warned against misinterpreting the nature of present Soviet communism.

Dodd also was critical of recent Government moves to improve relations with Communist nations.
