I have disagreed with many facets of the investigation, especially the one bullet theory and my views are well known on this aspect.


I will be glad to appear before this special committee and give them my thoughts.

I shall appreciate your contacting Rep. Preyer and arrange for this through your office.


I was asked to send my thoughts to the Sen. Church Investigative Committee, which I did about seven months ago, but that Committee has since been disbanded.
