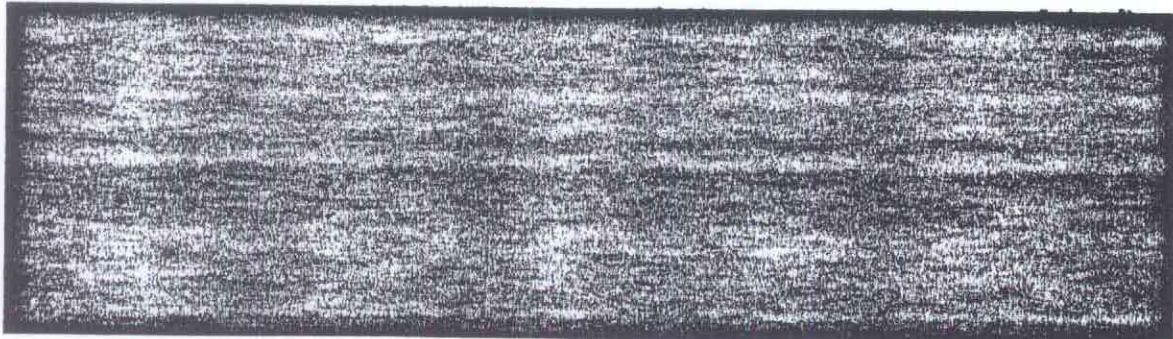

6/22/68 Sat. from 5 am to 12 midnight.



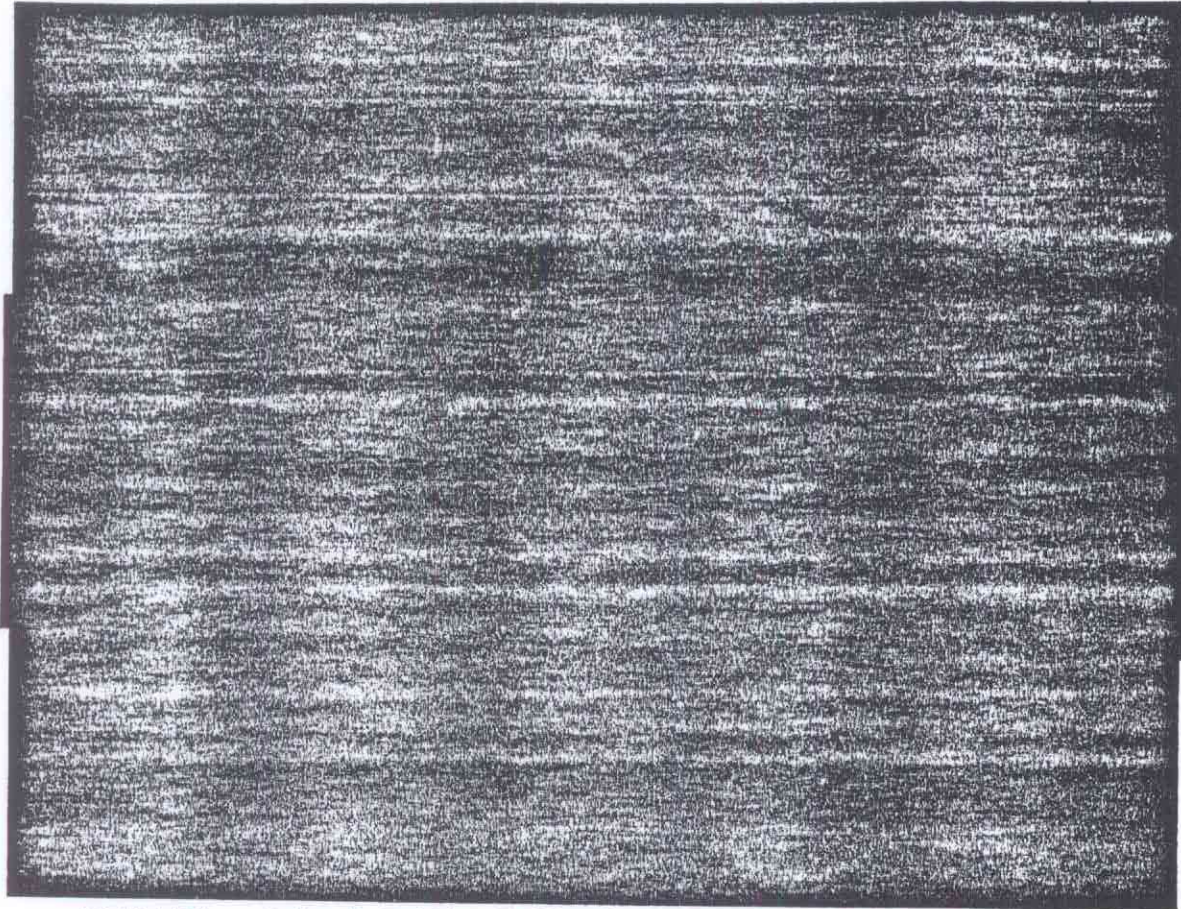

"6/24/68 - John B Smith Ballard, McKenzie, Brooks, House & Milton Mack & one other M/C from MSU will be the delegation from the Invaders. Going to ask for \$500.00 for their support against former Mayor Ingram. If they get the money from Mayor Loeb they are going to take the money to Virginia & buy more Robitussin AC.

"\$80.00 was spent of Robitussin AC during the trip into Tenn. Money allegedly came from Chas. Ballard as he is working & gave John B. Smith \$100.00.

"Ballard is making 90.00 a week as Director of Neighborhood Organizing Project, an adjunct or program of the Memphis War on Poverty Committee."

It is noted that [REDACTED] has advised as recently 7/7/68 that the "HERBERT T." referred to by [REDACTED] is undoubtedly the same as "WILL T," a Beale Street hustler. They have the same description and the same wearing apparel. Each wears a yacht captain type cap.
