BLACK ORGANIZING

On May 27, 1968 there was a mooting at Bothlohom Eaptist Church at 273 Inglo, botween the polico department and a P.T.A. committee from Carver high School along with representatives of a legal ... black power group known as the INVADERS.

The police department was represented by Fire and Police Director Frank Holloman, and Chief Henry Lux. There were approx. 35-30 people thoro, and those known to informant mere as follows:

- 1. Rov. R. W. Taylor, pastor of Bothlohen
- 2. City Compo Tman James L. Notters 3. Oreo McKenzio, member of the Invader.
- 4. Richard Cabbage, of the Invaders. 5. Verdell Ercoks, of the Invaders.
- 6. (FNU) Norwood, Invadors.
 7. Ewall Famion, (phonic) (Action Single)

The older people at the meeting seemed to agree with Director Holloman, about "maintaining communications in the creas", but the local black power advocates known as the Invadors, did not go along with this belief.

Ewall Famion, (phonic) stated "the police department is putting you down," he further said that the negroes should gain complete control of the whole community.
