On 3/16/68 WILBURN HENDERSON, Investigator, Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), Federal Office Building, Memphis, Tenn., advised SA WILLIAM H. LAWRENCE as follows:

Rev. MALCOM DOUGLAS BLACKBURN, white male, is an alien from Canada. He has alien registration # [REDACTED]. He entered the United States on 7/7/60 at Niagara Falls, N. Y., as a permanent citizen under visa # [REDACTED], issued to MALCOM DOUGLAS BLACKBURN by Canadian Government at Ottawa, Canada, 6/1/60, due to expire 5/31/65. He had Canadian birth certificate issued Victoria, British Columbia, # [REDACTED], registration # [REDACTED] showing that MALCOM DOUGLAS BLACKBURN was born 5/27/27 at Cranbrook, B. C., father - MALCOM STEWART BLACKBURN, residence Cranbrook, B.C., of Scotch origin, born Beach Burg, Ontario, mother-RUTH ROSE BARR of Cranbrook, B.C., of Irish origin, born Urbania, Nova Scotia.

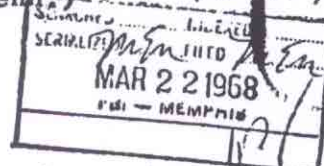

saying that BLACKBURN was scheduled to begin work 7/1/60 as Associate Executive Director of the Department of Stewardship and Benevolence, Division of Christian Life and Work, National Council of Churches, 475 Riverside Dr., N.Y., N.Y., at a salary of \$8,280 per year.

As of 6/30/61 BLACKBURN lived at 24 Demarest St., Demarest, N. J., and had previously lived at 805 Charlotte Terrace, Ridgefield, N. J.

Previously as of 6/60 he lived at 93 Chillery Ave., Scarborough, Ontario. He was listed as a minister.

He listed his wife as ELSA HELEN SCHROEDER, 93 Chillery Ave., Scarborough, Ontario.

He listed his children as CATHERINE ELSA BLACKBURN and ELIZABETH ANN BLACKBURN.

He listed his parents as MALCOM STEWART BLACKBURN, father, 1316 7th Ave., New Westminster, B.C., Canada, and his mother as RUTH ROSE BARR, same address.

He claimed to have been a member of the Canadian Musicians Union, 9/48 to 5/49.

He listed other prior residences as follows:

To date, he has not applied for citizenship.

He apparently came to Memphis in 1964 as his 1964 alien registration card showed that he lived at 1486 Court Ave., Memphis, and his prior address as 24 Demarest Ave., Demarest, N. J. He showed his 1964 employment as African Methodist Episcopal Church, 280 Hernando.

He was arrested by the Memphis PD 3/5/68 on a disorderly conduct charge (sit-in at Memphis City Hall already reported), arrest #103869. He listed Memphis residence as 857 Woodland, Memphis, and listed his wife as ELSA SCHROEDER, 24 Demarest Ave., Demarest, N. J.
