

SGA Forum Panelists Changed

Two panel members for the Human Relations Forum have been changed because of previous commitments since the meeting forum had to be rescheduled.

Richard Croppan, history professor from Siena College and Rev. Roy Dillinger, assistant di-

rector of the Tennessee Human Relations Council will replace Rev. Stanley McEvin, chaplain of Newman Foundation, and Rev. Charles Martin, assistant pastor of St. Patrick's Catholic Church. The other panelists will be Eugen Schoenfeld, assistant professor of

sociology at MSU, and Colby Smith, a student at Southwestern.
