

Bomb Damages Cuban's Business

MIAMI (AP) — A bomb last night blew out a door, smashed three boats and caused an estimated \$20,000 damage to the Hialeah Boatworks of Ramon Donestevez, controversial Cuban exile leader who faces deportation from this country.

Donestevez blamed another group of Cuban exiles for the blast at his Piranha Boatworks in Hialeah.

Police said a fuse bomb was placed against a double door at the rear of the building.

Donestevez has a deportation hearing scheduled in Washington Oct. 15 for allegedly violating an order prohibiting him from leaving the country. Donestevez led a party of exiles to Cuba recently to seek the release of political prisoners.
