At 7:10pm this date, Clerk Wm. Roberts, Springfield Division telephonically advised that additional data developed from a Chicago Tribune newspaper clipping of about a year ago indicated that the sister of the subject was working as a go-go dancer at the Bourbon St., 936 N. Rush, her associates were JOY TOMERS, CAROL MILLER and the instructor of these girls was DEBBIE GREEN. RAY's sister danced under the name LEE RILEY.

ROBERTS was advised that Chicago agents had located and interviewed SUSAN JANE DONIAN, he advised this was the person he was speaking of and he would not send in by teletype the above. He was advised no specific leads had been developed at this time from DONIAN to locate the subject.
