Californians Called in JFK Probe

The district attorney's office subpensed two Californians today to testify in the Orleans Parish Grand Jury's probe of the Kennedy assassination.

Criminal Court Judge Matthew S. Braniff issued orders directing Dr. Stanley L. Drennan of Los Angeles and Clinton Wheat of Burney, Calif., to appear before the grand jury May 29 and 30.

In requesting the subpenas, the DA's office alleged that Dr. Drennan was present in 1963 at a discussion concerning the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. It further alleged that Wheat in 1963 participated in discussions at his home regarding the assassination.

DA Jim Garrison has accused retired New Orleans businessman Clay L. Shaw with conspiring to kill President Kennedy. Shaw's trial is set June 11.
