DETAILS

SYNOPSIS

Attempt to locate William Duff in Dallas made with negative results. Duff reported by FBI to be in the U. S. Army stationed at Base Hospital, Ft. Sill, Oklahoma.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to Chief's O/M dated Feb. 11, 1964, requesting interview of William M. Duff re his whereabouts on November 22, 1963. Further reference is made to M/R of SA Howlett dated Jan. 22, 1964, re the attempted assassination of General Edwin A. Walker at Dallas, Texas.

Other Investigations

On Feb. 20, 1964 inquiry was made at the Dallas Police Department relative to William McCune Duff, Dallas Police Department #52495, FBI #483 264 E. Records at the Dallas Police Dept. indicate that Duff was wanted for a residence burglary, the wanted notice filed Oct. 26, 1963 - no disposition on this case. Further information from these records indicates that Duff was born on Nov. 4, 1931 at Grangemouth, Stirlingshire, Scotland; that he is 5-8 $\frac{1}{2}$, 159#, black hair, grey eyes, shows occupation as locomotive engineer.

The above record shows one relative, Mrs. H. Duff, mother, residing at 7614 Glanden Way, South San Gabriel, California.

Investigation was conducted at the last known address of William Duff, 4919 San Jacinto, Apt. 214, Dallas, Texas. This investigation indicated that Duff does not presently live at this address nor had he ever lived at this address.

Inquiry was made of the FBI, Dallas, Texas, at which time it was determined
