The case you inquired about is <u>United States v. Miller</u>. The reversal is reported at 411 F.2d 825 (2d Cir. 1969). There were half a dozen or so reported opinions prior to that. The direct appeal is in 381 F.2d.

I have had some correspondence with Mr. Weisman about the Ray case, and the Miller case. Of course I have no basis for doubting Ray's guilt, but there would seem to be at least a prima facie case of a sellout, and there would seem to be ground for a full airing of the case.

My files are now in a state of horrible disarray. When I get them straightened out, I'll send you some news clippings and articles on the Miller Case.
