I also expect you to be certain that if you have an inquiry it is a legitimate one. By this I mean not under cover for a federal agency. There is a reason. I sue the FBI with some regularity and success under the Freedom of Information Act. Two such cases are in federal courts now and one has gone to the Supreme Court.
