REBUTELCALL TO MIAMI MARCH 29, 1977.

AT 7:10 P.M., MARCH 29, 1977, [REDACTED] FORMER CIA INTELLIGENCE OFFICER, TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED WILLIAM O. CREGAR, DEPUTY ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, INTELLIGENCE DIVISION, FBIHQ, AND ADVISED THAT MR. EDWARD J. EPPSTEIN (PH.), WHO IS AN OUT-STANDING INVESTIGATIVE REPORTER DOING RESEARCH UNDER A CONTRACT WITH READER'S DIGEST LOOKING INTO THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, TELEPHONICALLY CONTACTED [REDACTED] EARLIER IN THE EVENING. EPPSTEIN ADVISED THAT HE HAD BEEN INTERVIEWING ONE (FNU) DE MOHRENSCHILD DE MOHRENSCHILD HAD BEEN DEPOSED BY THE WARREN COMMISSION. [REDACTED] BELIEVED THAT DE MOHRENSCHILD'S DEPOSITION WAS INCOMPLETE INADEQUATE AND PROBABLY DID NOT REPRESENT DE MOHRENSCHILD'S COMPLETE KNOWLEDGE OF THE MATTER. EPPSTEIN DEBRIEFED DE MOHRENSCHILD AND ON THE FIRST DEBRIEFING OBTAINED "EXTRA-ORDINARY REVELATIONS." FOLLOWING AN EARLY MORNING DEBRIEFING

FRIDAY, MARCH 29, 1975, EPPSTEIN RETURNED TO DE MOHRENSCHILD'S RESIDENCE AND LEARNED HE HAD JUST COMMITTED SUICIDE.

ACCORDING TO EPPSTEIN, DE MOHRENSCHILD LEFT WITH AN UNKNOWN LAWYER IN DALLAS, TEXAS, A PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD HOLDING A RIFLE. THIS IS NOT BELIEVED TO BE A NEW PHOTOGRAPH, BUT ONE WHICH IT IS BELIEVED FBI HAS SEEN BEFORE. HOWEVER, ACCORDING TO DE MOHRENSCHILD, THE PHOTO HE LEFT WITH THE LAWYER WAS INSCRIBED BY MARINA OSWALD WITH THE FOLLOWING: "LONG LIVE THE ASSASSINS." [REDACTED] HAS LONG BEEN OF THE OPINION THAT THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION WAS AN INTERNATIONAL ESPIONAGE CASE IN THAT OSWALD WAS USED BY THE SOVIETS. [REDACTED] ALSO RAISES THE QUESTION COULD THE DE MOHRENSCHILD DEATH BE THE WORK OF THE SOVIETS RATHER THAN SUICIDE.

EDWARD J. EPPSTEIN IS STAYING AT THE BREAKERS, KEY WEST, FLORIDA, TELEPHONE NUMBER (305) 655-6611, EXTENSION 4179.

MIAMI SHOULD IMMEDIATELY INTERVIEW EPPSTEIN REGARDING REVELATIONS MADE TO HIM BY DE MOHRENSCHILD. MIAMI SHOULD USE WILLIAM O. CREGAR'S NAME AND EPPSTEIN'S TELEPHONE CONTACT WITH [REDACTED] TO SUBSTANTIATE BONA FIDES FOR INTERVIEW. SINCE PROBABLY NO ONE IN THE MIAMI OFFICE IS COMPLETELY FAMILIAR WITH OSWALD CASE, TELL EPPSTEIN THAT, BUT THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO HAVE ALL THE INFORMATION DE MOHRENSCHILD FURNISHED EPPSTEIN WHICH WOULD CONSTITUTE NEW REVELATIONS OR SUBSTANTIATE INFORMATION.

MIAMI SHOULD INTERVIEW EPPSTEIN, GET ALL THE INFORMATION HE HAS BEEN ABLE TO OBTAIN FROM DE MOHRENSCHILD, SEND IMMEDIATE TELETYPE IN TO FBIHQ, AND FBIHQ WILL EVALUATE TO DECIDE WHAT LEADS SHOULD BE SET OUT FOR OTHER OFFICES INVOLVED.

BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBLE SIGNIFICANCE OF NEW REVELATIONS, EPPSTEIN SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED TO REFRAIN FROM FURNISHING THESE REVELATIONS TO ANY OTHER POLICE AGENCY OR NEWS MEDIA UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE NEW REVELATIONS CAN BE EITHER SUBSTANTIATED OR PROVEN FALSE.

IN ADDITION, MIAMI TAKE STEPS TO DETERMINE WHETHER THERE IS ANY PROBABILITY OR POSSIBILITY THAT DE MOHRENSCHILD'S DEATH COULD HAVE BEEN OTHER THAN SUICIDE.

IMMEDIATE TELETYPE TO FBIHQ CONCERNING EPPSTEIN'S INTERVIEW SHOULD NOT BE DELAYED TO GATHER ADDITIONAL FACTS REGARDING DE MOHRENSCHILD'S DEATH.
