

One More Probe Of Assassination

Another Congressional committee has begun investigating the Warren Commission report. Representative Don Edwards of California, chairman of the House Civil and Constitutional Rights Subcommittee, said his panel's purpose was not to reopen the commission's report but to "set the record straight on just what went on."

A Senate subcommittee earlier began a study of the report following disclosures that the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Central Intelligence Agency had withheld information from the commission. There has been no suggestion that the commission's conclusion, that Lee Harvey Oswald was the sole assassin of President Kennedy, was incorrect.
