There is a note added to 62-109060-2953 (not attached) which reads "on Sp Loc. ? as in special location, perhaps.

The record is a cover-the-bureau Ballas teletype of 11/30/63, which is to say of about the time the Fol began to feel the criticisms of it ever the assessination.

The record is one of many of threats against the President made and known prior to his 11/22/63 trip to Dallas. These are all of historical importance, particularly because of the FAI's semaitivity to criticism and the fact of the kilding then and there.

Whatever is represented by "Mp Loc" I have received no records from it.

In this teletype the FMI pretence that it gave the information it obtained to other agencies, those who unlike the FSU had responsibilities for the President's security. Actually the first information was by these other agencies, especially the Dallas police. The FOI glids the lily with its recounting of its alleged efforts with regard to the reported plan by Normal tes alkins to embarrase the President.

(Anything short of actuals killing was of no significance to the Fal.)

The description of the plan to embasines the frusident is considerably understated, as is limiting it to this one person. In fact it was a smooth and in fact their description of what they would do in "rub his dick in the cirt."

The nates is reposited three times, each time with the characteristic Deloach initialling. In each case a different threat is referred to in the text.
