ABSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY NORMAN LEE ELEIRS RACIAL MATTERS

On 10/29/63, Chief of Police JESSE E. CURRY telephonically contacted me at the FBI office late in the afternoon. Chief CURRY stated that the Chief of Police at Denton, Chief ANDERSON, had contacted him relative to one MCRMAN LEE ELKINS. He stated ANDERSON told him he felt ELKINS, who resided in Denison, Texas, might possibly be organizing some action to embarrass the President on his visit to Dallas. CURRY asked if the FBI had a photograph and background information concerning ELKINS. I told him the name was not familiar to me but I would check our files and call him back.

After reviewing the files of this effice, I called Chief CURRY back and told him we did have some background information and a photograph of MORMAN LEE ELKINS. He stated he would on the following day send Lt. JACK REVILL to our office for the information and photograph.

I attempted to reach FORREST FORRELS, U. R. Secret Rervice, at his office, but did not reach him at that time. I did reach him at approximately 6 p.m. that date.

On the morning of 10/30/63, Lt. JACK REVILL of the Intelligence Unit of the Dallas PD contacted me at the effice of the FBI in Dallas. He stated he wanted to get the background information on MORMAN LEE ELEINS of Denison, Texas. I discussed this previously with SA WALLACE R. MEITMAN, at which time SA HEITMAN reviewed the background information with Lt. REVILL. Prior to reviewing the background information I called Mr. SCRRELLS on the telephone and told him that Lt. REVILL of the Dallas PD on instructions of Chief of Police CURRY was going to Denison, Texas, to interview ELEINS. I also gave him information Chief CURRY had furnished this efficient at teld Mr. SCRRELLS that REVILL was in the effice and if he desired to talk with him by telephone he could do so and make

what arrangements he wanted to with the PD. SCRRELLS stated he would like to send a man with REVILL to Denison. I handed the telephone to REVILL and he talked with Mr. SCRRELLS at --length.
