WAR NOW!

WILL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ASK AMERICAN BOYS TO DIE IN THE VIETNAM WAR." "THE TIME IS COMING VERY SOON WHEN THE U.S. NO LONGER

So said Averell Harriman on February 11th of this year.

Since then 5,000 American boys have died, 31,300 American boys have been wounded. In addition, 75,000 military Vietnamese have died from acts of war committed by both sides. Vietnamese civilian casualty figures are not known but are estimated up to ten times the military figure. In all, over 36,300 American and over 595,000 Vietnamese military have been killed since American intervention in 1961. 233,000 Americans have been wounded in these 8½ years.

NOW COME!

The undersigned believe that a military solution to the Viet Nam War is impossible and that a continued war will only mean more bloodshed — American and Vietnamese.

We urge the following as the road to peace.

1. Halt all offensive miltary operations in Vietnam, including search and destroy missions.

2. Commit ourselves to withdrawal of all our troops within one year, and begin withdrawal immediately.
