"THE TIME IS COMING VERY SOON WHEN THE U.S. NO LONGER WILL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ASK AMERICAN BOYS TO DIE IN THE VIETNAM WAR."

So said Averell Harriman on February 11th of this year.

Since then 2,721 American boys have died, 20,188 American boys have been wounded. In addition, 42,712 military Vietnamese have died from acts of war committed by both sides. Vietnamese civilian casualty figures are not known but are estimated at ten times the military figure. In all, over 250,000 Americans and over 700,000 Vietnamese have been killed or wounded since American intervention in 1961.
