Dear George,

Here is the Order of which I told you.

= While the suit is against GSA and is for the ex. sess. transcripts a central issue is the representations of the CIA, as in the Briggs affidavit of which you have a copy.

= I'll be in D.C. on another suit tomorrow and Jim and I will discuss this. I do not know who we can call, whether there will be immediate trial or depositions of Robinson will not follow the desires of the appeals court.

But I do believe that there will be problems for the government, for Epstein and for his book.

There is no doubt that we will now be able to perfect the record and that we will give the district court much if not all that we asked the appeals court to consider.

There is also no doubt that if Robinson does not ignore the appeals court he will face a question of false swearing. I believe this false swearing is so material that it is perjury if false.

If I have time there is something else I received today I'll include with some comments. No time now because I'm off for my weekly test of rat-poison level and have a seminar this afternoon.
