Dear Mr. Weisberg:

I called the National Desk of the Washington Post last night right after talking with you and of course they bucked the thing to Ben Bradlee, by saying "If we didn't run something in this morning's paper that moved on the AP wire yesterday, I don't have any idea what factors entered into the decision-making process not to use it." Clifton Daniel at the Times and Bradlee at the Post and their publishers are just too locked into the establishment of this town to rock this particular boat yet. I think the assassination thing is building however into a crescendo of facts that will simply overwhelm them in the coming months and they'll be forced to report and publish.

Enclosing a check for \$6.25 for Whitewash # 4. I'll be going down to the National Archives at lunch today to get the transcript of Jan. 22, 1964.
