- 3. Is the January 27, 1964, transcript being withheld from research on the grounds that it is an investigatory file compiled for law enforcement purposes?
- 4. If so, what is the specific law enforcement purpose for which this January 27, 1964, transcript was compiled?
  - 5. On what date did this law enforcement/come into being?
- 6. Is there any pending law enforcement action or proceeding which involves this January 27, 1964, transcript?
  - 7. If so, what is that proceeding?
- 8. Was this January 27, 1964, transcript ever made available to the District Attorney of Dallas County, Texas? to the Texas Attorney General? to the Texas Court of Inquiry which investigated the murders of President Kennedy and Lee Harvey Oswald?
- 9. To what "developments in the state of the law" was Mr.
  Richard Q. Vawter, Director of Information, General Services Administration, referring in his February 8, 1972, letter to Harold Weisberg (See Plaintiff's Exhibit D, Complaint)?
