Legit London advised Govt board in London which grants legal aid certificates has refused to grant certificate to James Earl Ray. Board has indicated it would be waste of money to take Ray's cause to high court. Solicitor acting for Ray is appealing board's decision. If committee upholds board's decision, Ray's legal actions end and case will not go to high court unless Ray or someone else put forth money for legal aid. Bureau will be advised of further developments.
