At 9:45 a. m. today Mr. Pollak, Assistant Attorney General, Rights Division, called to advise me that they are still interested in Irle Q. Stephens from whom they would like to get an affidavit. The individual who was in the rooming house in Memphis occupied by subject Ray at the time of the commission of the offense. A memorandum has been submitted to the British authorities, however, and we plan to submit a supplementary memorandum in affidavit form for locating Stephens.

According to Pollak, attorney Flannery is now in Memphis and will be in touch with the Memphis office. Pollak said he understood Stephen's wife was a invalid. I said this was true but did not know whether she is still living or not and the last we had heard of Stephens he was living on skid row. I advised Pollak we would like to know just as soon as Stephens or John Webster De Shazo has been located.

De Shazo is the individual who was in the gun shop in Birmingham and picked Ray from a photograph as the individual who purchased the gun in question. De Shazo is presently on a vacation trip in Colorado and Arizona. We have leads out for him and are trying to locate him.
