Dear Mr. Hoover:

A number of statements have been attributed to you recently, concerning the Warren Commission and the assassingtion of President Kennedy. I wondered if you have a public statement as to your opinions on the validity of the Warren Com-mission's finding in the conclusion that Lee Harvey Oswald was alone in his carrying out of the assassination of the President.

On many occasions your statements to the public are edited, and it is extremely difficult to ascertain what actually has been said. One small paragraph in quotation marks is included in a long article made up primarily of editorializing and the opinions of the writer as to exactly what you meant. In this case, I feel that the opinion that you express will be of utmost importance as far as the public is concerned.

I am not just requesting this as a matter of personal curiosity I have the unique opportunity of utilizing the radio on the West Coast, addressing between 150,000 and 200,000 people, lquite frequently, in the evenings. I always try to check my facts ahead of time, to make certain that they are correct, and would certainly appreciate your help in clarifying the statements that have been attributed to you.
