DEAR MR. BYRNE,

I quite agree with you: where are Jack Kennedy's friends? I've not in any way changed the opinions I expressed about them in the epilogue to "HILL-WASH II".

Cervini Cushing is aging, has many other responsibilities, and is perhaps troubled by the kinds of complications he could get into. I was in Boston in September and tried to get to speak with him. He had appointments made in advance and was tied up all the time I was there.

I cannot begin to try and get in touch with those allegedly the friends of the late President. They'd fear it if I did anyway. So, we plug along, doing what we feel we must as we can. If we have to do it alone, we will.

I do not scoff at what you say. While I do not have extra-sensory perception or anything like that, I am untroubled because I have long felt that ~~the feeling that~~ what I am doing is predestined and will succeed.

Nor do I laugh at what so-called medical scientists do not accept. I have had my own experience. I have a lower-back injury that no doctor has ever been able to help. I have misgivings about chiropractic, but I know I have walked into the chiropractor's office with the greatest difficulty and pain and on crutches and walked out without help or pain.
